




or rubber balls,




or even sticks.


This puppy is chewing on somebody's sneaker.

at animals much bigger than they are.








Best of all, they like barking at cats.

or birds,




or squirrels.



But they almost never catch anything.




Puppies like to dig, especially where the dirt is nice and soft, as in a garden.



This makes them very dirty, but they don't care.


Puppies are like that!
