Spencer and his friends are choosing their favorite shapes.

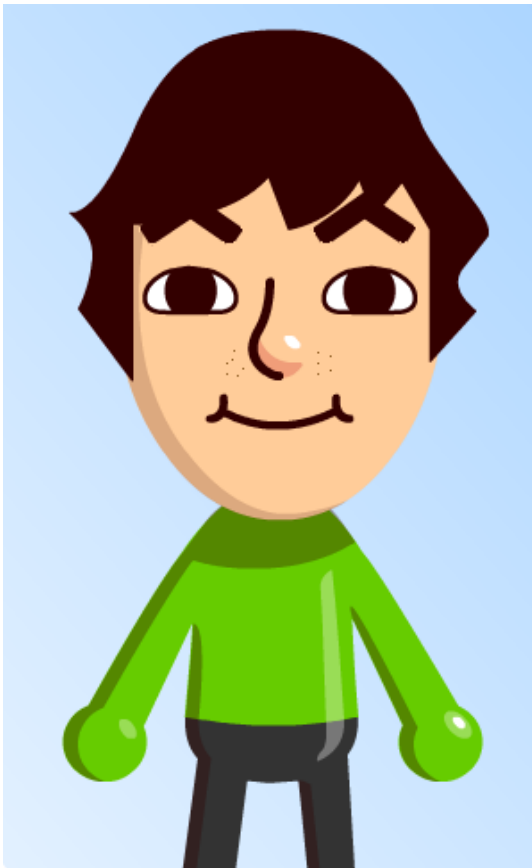
There are lots of shapes to choose from.



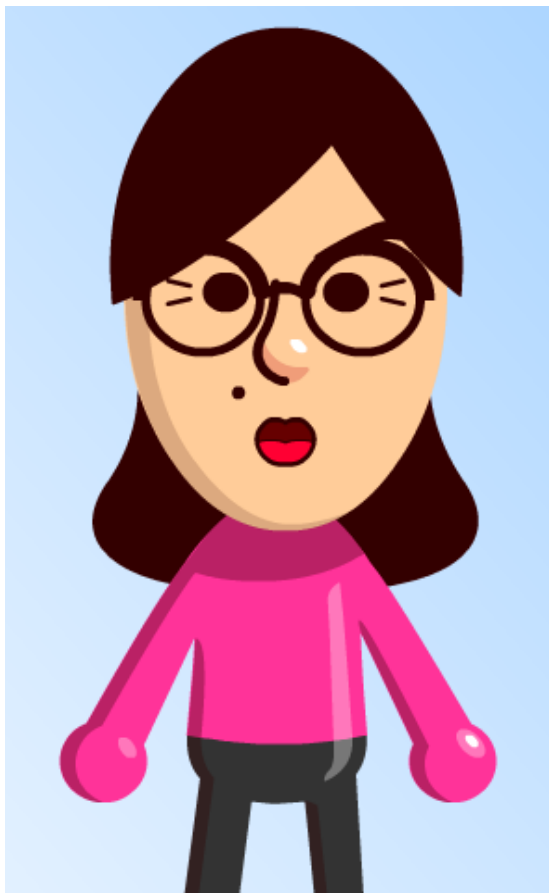
Grace likes

sandwiches.



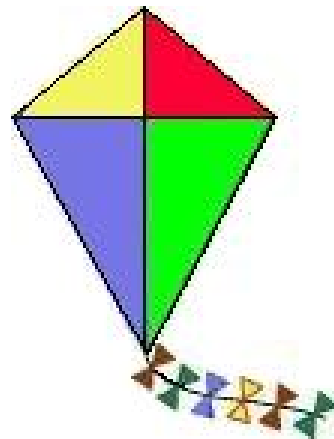
Pete likes stars

telescope.



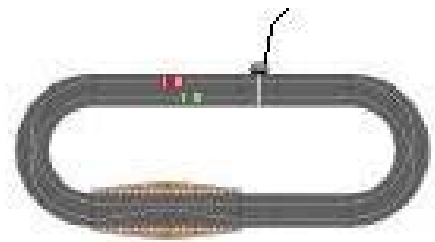
Kitty likes

like her TV.



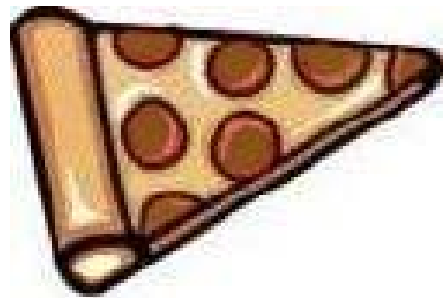
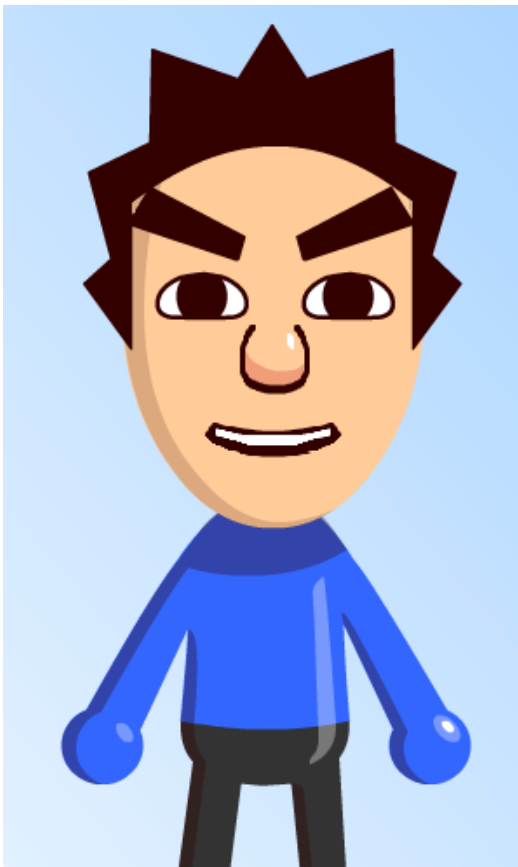

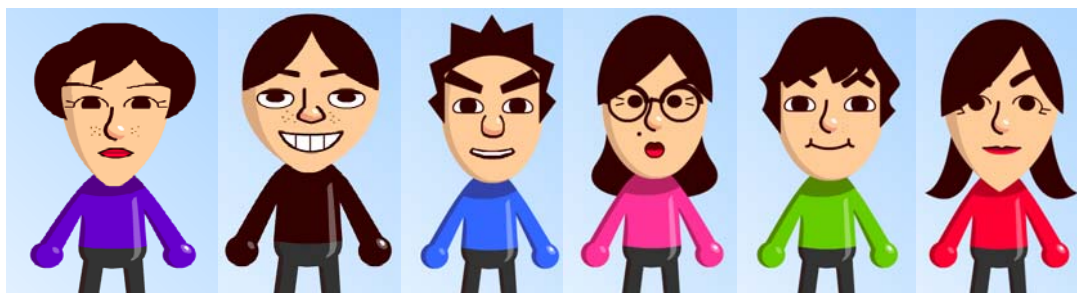
